Starting in Barnsley town centre, right outside the iconic Town Hall the riders will make their way through the borough, passing some of our best known visitor attractions including Cooper Gallery, Worsborough Mill and Elsecar Heritage Centre.

The Barnsley section of the race has one classified climb 'Côte de Blacker Hill', which will challenge riders to a steep incline and sharp bends as they ascend towards Hoyland.
